2016-2017 : A year of growth and achievement

Dear All,

I am happy to share that this year was a year of growth within Karnataka. We established two new branches in Ranebennur (Northern part of Karnataka) and Mysore to support the youths for education and livelihood program and we have recorded a growth of 25% this year and have trained 120 students.

We extended our wings towards the hearing impaired. I take this opportunity to thank HSBC of recognizing Snehadeep among 800 applicants across India for skill development program . I was very proud to know that Snehadeep was one among the 15 for this skill development program in India.

Managing Trustee

Over the year we were able to train 30 hearing impaired and have set plans to provide services to more number of hearing impaired this year too . 120 Visually impaired were benefited from the livelihood program and we have touched lives of 3239 beneficiaries through aids and equipments across India. We conducted first ever walkathon at Ranebennuru where 300 visually impaired and hearing impaired across the Haveri Dist participated thus creating awareness among the people.

We are heading into this new year with a positive outlook and we hope to increase many beneficiaries to our fold. To accommodate more students and provide more faculties to our students. We have planned to shift the existing premises at Ranebennur to a better location. We are excited to introduce football to Blind fraternity and we have started a football academy to identify and train prospective football players across India and registered separate wing for football called All India Blind Football Association in India consisting of representatives heading institutions working for the visually impaired across India.

I extend my whole hearted appreciation and gratitude to hundreds of volunteers who devoted their time and energy in providing services to our differently abled, I thank the donors and well wishers in India , Hong Kong , UK, USA and Singapore for their magnanimous contributions both in kind and monetary . I thank my staffs for dedicating their entire time and effort for the upliftment of the children at Snehadeep.

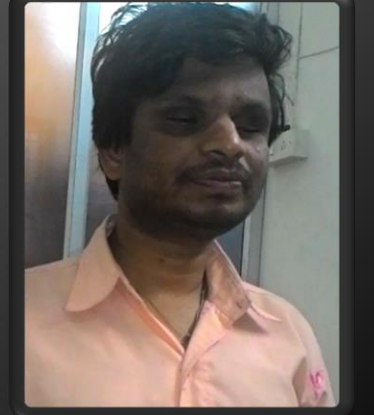

▶ State level Cultural Extravaganza for the Blind

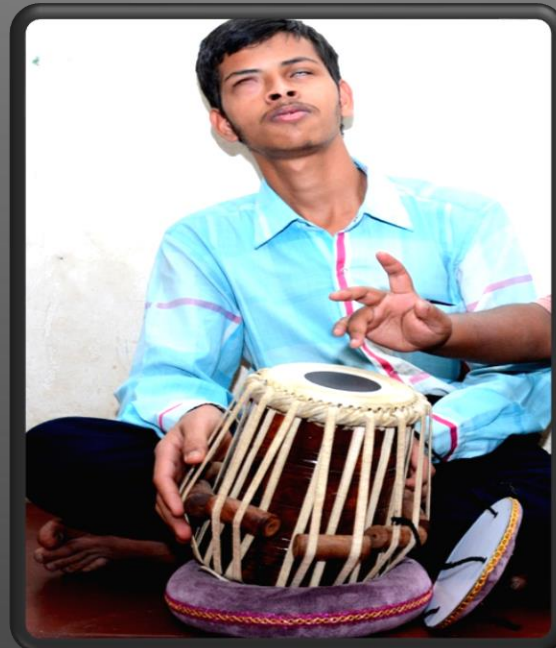
